

St. Ignatius Parish Preschool Admissions Policies

Age

For the three year old program students need to be at least 2 years, nine months old by September 1.

For the four year old program, students need to be at least 3 years, nine months old by September 1.

Bathroom Skills

All students must have independent bathroom skills.

Priority

Applications for preschool will be prioritized according to the following:

- A. Established Parishioners with children presently enrolled in preschool or elementary school;
- B. Established Parishioner without children presently enrolled in preschool or elementary school;
- C. Non-Parishioner - Catholic with children in preschool or elementary school;
- D. Non-Parishioner - Catholic without children in preschool or elementary school;
- E. Non-Parishioner - Non-Catholic with children in preschool or elementary school;
- F. Non-Parishioner - Non-Catholic without children in preschool or elementary school.

An established parishioner is one who is registered in the parish and has been a sustaining parish member for at least one year. A sustaining parish member is one who attends Sunday Mass regularly, contributes using envelopes or checks and participates in the life of the parish.

Elementary School Admission

Enrollment in St. Ignatius Parish Preschool does not guarantee admission to St. Ignatius Parish Elementary School.
