



Missoula Children's Theatre (MCT) is coming to St. Ignatius on May 6th, 2024.

MCT, the nation's largest touring children's theater, has been touring extensively for over 40 years now from Montana to Japan, and will visit over 1,200 communities this year with 44 teams of Tour Actor/Directors. A tour team will arrive at St. Ignatius with a set, lights, costumes, props and make-up, everything it takes to put on a play...except the cast. The team will hold an audition and **cast 50-60 students K-8th** to perform in the production. The show will be rehearsed throughout the week and a public performance will be presented on Saturday. All MCT shows are original adaptations of classic children's stories and fairytales . . . a *twist* on the classic stories that you know and love. This year we will be producing "Beauty Lou and the Country Beast". Creativity, social skills, goal achievement, communication skills and self-esteem are all characteristics that are attained through participation in this unique, educational project. MCT's mission is *the development of life skills in children through participation in the performing arts*.

### Auditions: Monday, May 6th, 2:00pm-4:00pm, Parish Center

To audition, return the attached permission slip by Thursday, May 2nd. Please look carefully at all the information on this sheet before you decide to audition. There are roles for 50-60 students. There is no guarantee that everyone who auditions will be cast in the play. It is a group audition - no advance preparation is necessary, but a SMILE  $\odot$  never hurts. Be ready to come and have a good time!

All cast member must attend this rehearsal Everyone auditioning must have a clear schedule for the entire week and be able to attend all rehearsals required for their role. A detailed rehearsal schedule will be distributed at the conclusion of the auditions. \*<u>SOME CAST</u> <u>MEMBERS WILL NOT BE REQUIRED AT ALL REHEARSALS. CAST MEMBERS</u> <u>SCHEDULED FOR THE FULL 4% HOURS OF REHEARSAL WILL NEED TO BRING</u> <u>A SACK SUPPER OR SNACK. (Kids K-2nd tend not to stay on Monday)</u>

All cast members must be available for all scheduled performances. Tickets for the performances will cost \$10.00 for ages 3yrs and up.

Missoula Children's Theatre presents BEAUTY LOU AND THE COUNTRY BEAST, an original country western adaptation of the classic fairy tale BEAUTY AND THE BEAST. Beauty Lou is the oldest daughter of the bronc-bustin' balladeer Buck. At the local county fair, young Beauty Lou is upset by the ungrateful behavior of a miner who has won the blue ribbon for his beautiful roses.
