- Students should be primarily responsible for the decorating!
- <u>All</u> decorations and support on or around house must be edible! This means everything except the base and the name tag!
- Please deliver all decorated houses to the Parish Center on Friday, November 30, from 7:45am-Noon. No late entries will be accepted.
- Please include the student's name and grade/category on the house's base where it is visible without lifting up the house.
- Judging will be performed by two teachers in the afternoon on Friday, November 30. Winners will be announced after the raffle during Breakfast with Santa.
- NOTE: Please pick up your gingerbread house at the end of the event. We cannot save any that are
  left at clean-up and they will be thrown out if not claimed, including the base. For the sake of
  fairness, please remember that for student-entries your child must be the only one decorating the
  ginger bread house and parent involvement should be kept to a minimum. Thank you for your
