

Philosophy

St. Ignatius Parish School holds as primary a belief in God and the Catholic Church. It is within this committed atmosphere that children develop self-respect, respect for others, and a reverence for all of God's creation.

Dress Code

Students may wear summer clothing with closed-toe shoes. Shorts should be modest in length resting at mid thigh. Shirts are to completely cover the midsection. No spaghetti strap or tank tops. If worn please use a cardigan or similar clothing over. If leggings are worn, the top must cover to mid high. T-Shirts with political affiliations, statements, or with inappropriate images or language are not allowed.

Closed Campus

St. Ignatius Parish School is a closed campus. Once students arrive on campus, they may not leave at any time during the school day unless they are signed out by an authorized adult. At the end of the day, students must follow the dismissal guidelines outlined below. Parents and guests are not permitted to walk around the school grounds or inside the school building without permission and a specific purpose. Parents must use the Main room (PC-3) for morning check in. All part time students will be walked to the main gate at 12:15 pm. Here parents or authorized adults will need to check out.

Code of conduct

Students are expected to behave in a respectful manner while attending St. Ignatius Summer camp program. If a child's behavior interferes with the program, consequences such as suspension or expulsion may occur.

The following items are not permitted: cell phones, smart watches, electronic devices, toy weapons or anything considered to be a weapon. Trading cards or toys from home.

Academics

Morning summer camp classes are available from 8:15 a.m.-12:15 p.m.

Classes consist of daily instruction, hands on projects, group work, science, reading, math, writing, recreational sports and more. Our classes are a combined class with two grades, one teacher and one classroom aide.

(TK for incoming TK 4-5 years and Kindergarten) This grade level will focus on writing, letter recognition, math, circle time, interactive play, social interaction, group projects, and much more.

(1st and 2nd Grade) This grade level will enjoy group reading, hands on projects, writing, movement, interactive play, social interaction, and more.

(3rd and 4th Grade) This grade level will focus on reading, writing stories, hands on projects, and reading to the lower grade classes.

(5th and 6th Grade) This grade level will be leaders to others! We will focus on group projects, reading to TK/K weekly, science projects, math projects, community service work, and more.

Teachers and Summer Camp Staff

Our summer camp teachers are current school staff members or from our local Catholic schools who are familiar with the school's mission and philosophy, as well as our Tk-8th grade curriculum. Our teachers will work with your children in a classroom setting reinforcing skills they learned throughout the year.

Registration, Attendance, and Fees

Students should enroll in the grade level that they will enter in the fall of 2020.

Registration will be accepted from March 01 - May 01, 2020. The emergency form, registration form, child immunization record and registration fee must be received together. Registration may increase to \$75.00 per child after the deadline or may not be accepted once your child's grade level is full. The non-refundable registration fee must accompany the registration form, emergency form (Pages 6 - 10) and current immunization record. Forms are available on our school website. All required forms and fees must be submitted together, we will not accept forms or payment separately. Tuition is due on Monday before camp begins. A late fee will be applied to your account if payment is not received by 12:15 pm. You may pay week by week or more than a week at a time.
