Your child must have independent bathroom skills to attend St. Ignatius Summer Preschool

Who can attend St. Ignatius Preschool?**

Summer Preschool is available to all Preschoolers ages 3 through 5 years old. However, if your child is registered and enrolled in St. Ignatius's 3 year old Preschool program, and is not quite 3, then you are eligible to attend. (They must have independent bathroom skills)

What is the summer schedule?

Our classes are 4 days a week from Monday through

<u>Thursday</u>. Our day starts at 8:00 a.m. and goes to 12:00 p.m.. You may arrive at your leisure. (The students who will be entering TK have the option to attend the Summer Program extended program run by St. Ignatius School (or the Summer **Preschool** Program)

How do I register?

Please fill out the registration form included in this brochure and return it along with the \$50 registration fee. Please make checks out to St. Ignatius School. (For those students who do not attend SI you will need to also get a packet with the CA state forms)

Does my child have to attend every day of the week I pay for?

No! You may attend only when you choose to attend but we will not refund money for days you choose to miss.

Do I have to choose all the weeks I want to attend right now?

Students may sign up for one week. all eight weeks or pick and choose. Please look over the schedule and pick what works for your schedule. We do ask that you register if you are planning on attending at any point in the summer. If you do choose a week you must pay a \$25 deposit for each week you choose. If you have not paid a deposit we may not have a spot for your child.

Do I have to pack a snack?

No! We will provide a healthy snack every day. We ask that you do NOT pack a snack for your child.

Can I do a drop in day as needed?
