- 36-#2 pencils, **sharpened**, standard yellow (non-mechanical, wooden pencils for Art & Science)
- 1-View-Thru 1-½" vinyl binder ("Easy Insert" style works well)
- 2-Pencil pouches with 3-rings
- 2-Pentel Hi-Polymer white erasers
- 2- highlighters (pink and yellow only)
- 1-scissors, kid-friendly (long sharp ones are unnecessary)
- 1 -12" ruler with centimeters and inches
- 4- Expo Dry Erase Markers (**Extra Fine**)-For cursive practice on white boards **AND** 4-Expo Dry Erase Markers
- 4-Black Papermate Flair markers
- 1- pkg wide-ruled binder paper
- 2- single subject spiral notebook (approx. 100 pages, but it doesn't have to be exact)
- 4-glue sticks
- 50 count plastic page protectors

- 1-box of colored pencils (Science)
