St. Ignatius Parish School Admissions Process

Applications for preschool, transitional-kindergarten, and kindergarten are **due January 31** for the next school year.

Applications are **accepted year-round** for all grade levels, preschool-8th grade. If an opening becomes available at any point in time, then the highest priority applicant will be contacted to move forward in the admissions process.

Applications are **prioritized** according to the following:

- 1. Established Parishioners* With children presently enrolled in school;
- 2. Established Parishioner* Without children presently enrolled in school;
- 3. New Parishioners* With children presently enrolled in school;
- 4. New Parishioner* Without children presently enrolled in school;
- 5. Non-Parishioner Catholic with children in school;
- 6. Non-Parishioner Catholic without children in school;
- 7. Non-Parishioner Non-Catholic with children in school;
- 8. Non-Parishioner Non-Catholic without children in school.

The application is an **online form** and it is available on the Admissions page of the school website: stignatiussacschool.org . There is no fee or commitment related to submitting an application.

If the applicant is currently enrolled in kindergarten to eighth grade then a copy of the most **recent report card** should be submitted to the school office or emailed to Katrena Paine at kpaine@stignatiussacschool.org . Also, please give the current teacher a copy of the **Applicant Information Form** and ask the teacher to send the form directly to St. Ignatius School.

If you would like to provide **prior year report cards**, **standardized testing reports or additional Applicant Information Forms** from other teachers or administrators then we are happy to receive these documents also.
