SI applied for and was awarded a \$100,000.00 grant for safety and security, the plan is to improve outside lighting, install more video cameras, install bollards around the building and to build fencing on the Arden way side of the property. The committee is getting bids & prioritizing. The grant was through Homeland Security.

## 5. Pastor Report

Fr. Mike reported that next week all of the priests from the Diocese would be at a convocation and there would be no morning mass. Fr. Mike or Fr. Tilley will attend the CSAC meetings. Fr. Mike expressed concerns as to why more families were not attending mass, he reminded the group that active parishioner status means attending mass as well as contributing \$600.00 per year. Fr. reported that the school finances were in better shape than the parish currently.

#### A. Annual Fund

Vanessa passed out the Annual Fund report, she reported letters are going out. There was discussion on how to reach more families. Facts has helped with the donations.
