



Missoula Children's Theatre (MCT) is coming to St. Ignatius on March 2, 2020.

MCT, the nation's largest touring children's theatre, has been touring extensively for over 30 years now from Montana to Japan, and will visit over 900 communities this year with 29 teams of Tour Actor/Directors. A tour team will arrive at St. Ignatius with a set, lights, costumes, props and make-up, everything it takes to put on a play…except the cast. The team will hold an audition and **cast 50-60 students K-8th** to perform in the production. The show will be rehearsed throughout the week and a public performance will be presented on Friday & Saturday. All MCT shows are original adaptations of classic children's stories and fairytales . . . a *twist* on the classic stories that you know and love. This year we will be producing "Johnny Appleseed". Creativity, social skills, goal achievement, communication skills and self-esteem are all characteristics that are attained through the participation in this unique, educational project. MCT's mission is *the development of life skills in children through participation in the performing arts*.

## Auditions: Monday, March 2nd, 2:00pm-4:00pm, Parish Center

To audition, return the attached permission slip by Monday, February 24th. Please look carefully at all the information on this sheet before you decide to audition. There are roles for 50-60 students. There is no guarantee that everyone who auditions will be cast in the play. It is a group audition - no advance preparation is necessary, but a SMILE onever hurts. Be ready to come and have a good time!

CAST MEMBERS SCHEDULED FOR THE FULL 4½ HOURS OF REHEARSAL WILL NEED TO BRING A SACK SUPPER OR SNACK (Kids K-2nd tend not to stay on Monday)

All cast members must be available for all scheduled performances. Tickets for the performances will cost \$8.00 for ages 3yrs and up.
