# XI. Amazing Grapes:

- a. School Speak billing was done for all invoicing. They did 55 billings online, received 17 back online. Most invoices have been paid, very little outstanding.
- b. Fundraiser raised over \$40,000.00
- c. 1<sup>st</sup> grade will receive new books from fundraiser
- d. Athletics will receive \$200 from fundraiser
- e. "Buy It Now" was success. The early bidding event raised \$12,900.00.
- f. \$5,500.00 left to collect

# XII. Spooktacular:

- b. 56% volunteer spots are filled
- c. Kitchen volunteer spots are 100% filled
- d. It was stressed for all food to be peanut free
- e. For safety purposes, bleachers will be taped off, no people allowed on bleachers

- g. "Square" can be used at bar instead of cash
