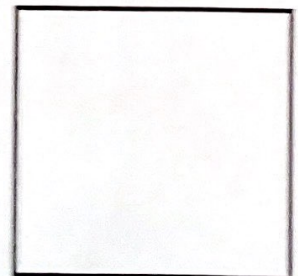
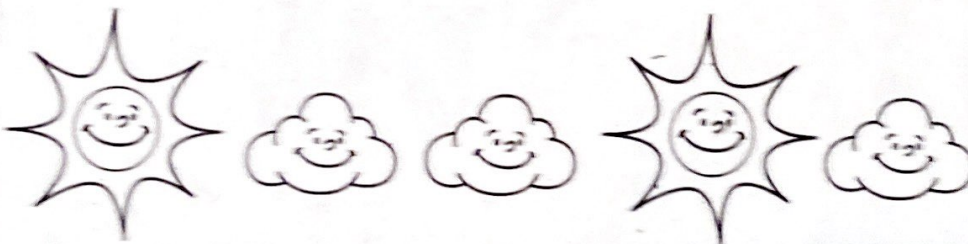
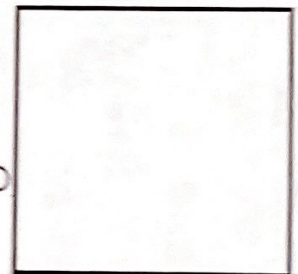
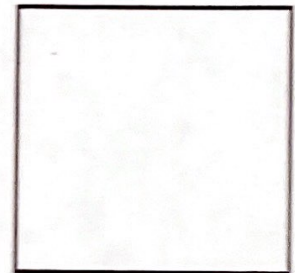
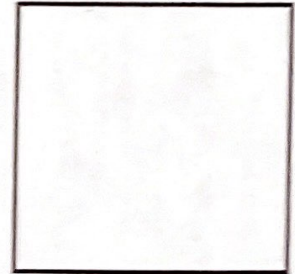
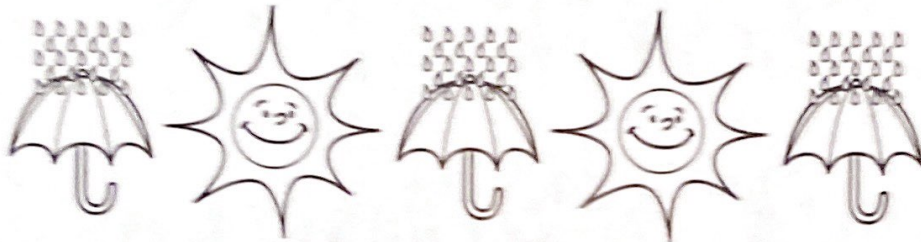


Weather Patterns
