Mission Statement

Philosophy

St. Ignatius parish school holds as primary a belief in God and the Catholic Church. It is within this committed atmosphere that children develop self-respect, respect for others, and a reverence for all of God's creation.

Dress Code

Students may wear summer clothing with closed-toe shoes. Shorts should be modest in length resting at mid thigh. Shirts are to completely cover the midsection. No spaghetti strap or tank tops. If worn, please use a cardigan or similar clothing over. If leggings are worn the top must cover to mid high. t-shirts with political affiliations, statements, or with inappropriate images or language are not allowed.

Closed Campus

St. Ignatius summer program is a closed campus. Once students arrive on campus they may not leave at any time during the day unless they are signed out by a parent or an authorized adult. At the end of the day students must follow the dismissal guidelines. Parents and guests are not permitted to walk around the school grounds or inside the school building without permission and a specific purpose.

Code of Conduct

Students are expected to behave in a respectful manner while attending St. Ignatius summer program. If a child's behavior interferes with the program, consequences such as suspension or expulsion may occur. The following items are not permitted: cell phones, smart watches, electronic devices, toy weapons or anything considered to be a weapon. Trading cards or toys from home.

Academics

Morning classes are available from 8:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m.

Classes consist of daily instruction, hands-on projects, group work, science, reading, math, writing, recreational sports and more. Most of our classes are a combined class with one or two grades, one teacher and aide.

TK for incoming TK 4-5 years and Kindergarten - This grade level will focus on writing, letter recognition, math, circle time, interactive play, social interaction, group projects, and much more.

1st and 2nd Grade - This grade will enjoy group reading, hands on projects, writing, movement, interactive play, social interaction, and more.

3rd and 4th Grade - This grade level will focus on reading, writing, stories, and hands-on projects.

5th and 6th Grade - The focus for this group will be on group projects, science projects, math, and much more.

Teachers and summer team

Our summer teachers are current school staff members or from our local Catholic schools who are familiar with the school's mission and philosophy, as well as our TK-6th grade curriculum. Our teachers will work with your children in a classroom setting reinforcing skills they learned throughout the 2025/26 school year.

Registration, attendance, and fees

Students should enroll in the grade level that they will enter in the fall of 2026. Registration will be accepted from March 17th - May 1st. The registration form must be completed and submitted by our deadline of May 1st, 2026. All fields must be completed in order to process. You may scan registration forms and email documents to arodriguez@stignatiussacschool.org or turn into our school office (attn: summer program / Mrs. Rodriguez)

Attn: Non SI students - registration fee must be paid at the time of submitting paperwork.

After paperwork has been submitted you will receive confirmation of your child(ren's) enrollment on or before May 23rd. If you do not receive a confirmation notice by this date, please reach out to the summer Director.

Does my child have to attend every day of the week I pay for?

No. You may attend certain days of the week to accommodate your family's schedule. However, refunds will not be available for missed days.

If my child(ren) signs up for full time, do they need to stay until 3:00 pm?

No. If your child is registered as a full time student you may pick up your child at any time convenient up until our closing time of 3:00 pm.

*****Please Note, that a \$5.00 a minute late fee will be applied for any student picked up after 3pm.**

Do I have to choose all the weeks I want to attend right now?

Yes. You must select the weeks you wish for your child/children to attend before submitting paperwork or our registration deadline.

If a week is selected your child must attend or a \$50 fee will apply.

Can I do a drop in day as needed?

Yes. We will do our best to accommodate your needs. However, the child must be enrolled in our summer program. The \$60 rate must be paid on the day of attendance. We ask that you call or email our Summer Director at 916 488-3907 ext 2 / arodriguez@stignatiussacschool.org ahead of time to ensure we have space for your child.

How do I pay for my child’s summer tuition?

For current St. Ignatius school families, tuition will automatically be paid via your FACTS account. If your child(ren) does not attend the selected week, a \$50 fee will apply.

Other Catholic school students will need to make weekly tuition payments on the days listed below.
