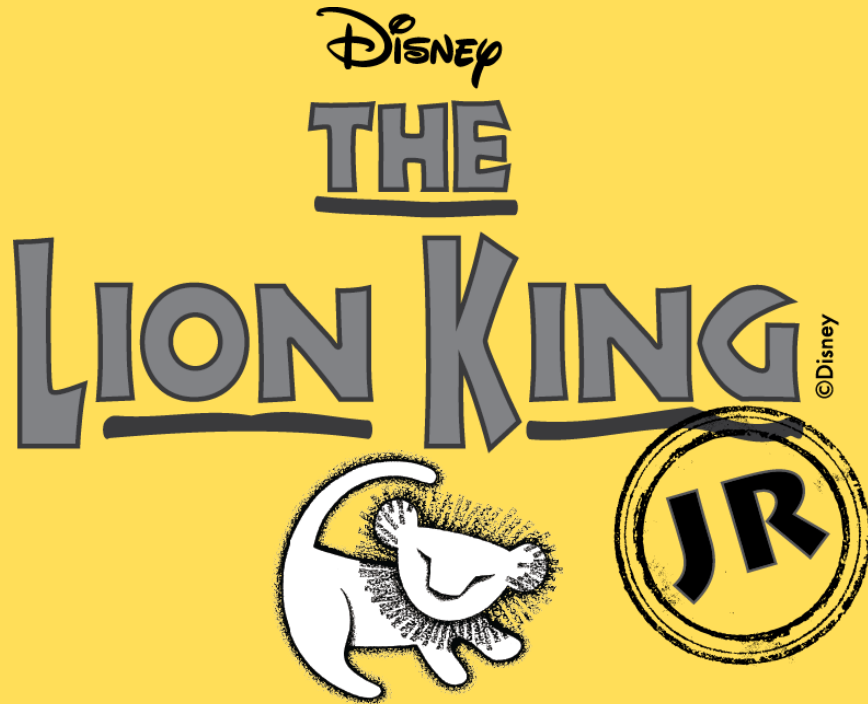

For the audition be ready to sing 30 seconds of a song of your choice A Capella (without music), and be ready to read sections of the play. Everyone is required to audition, even if interested in the non-acting roles.

Scripts will be given out after auditions, and roles will be emailed/announced before the second class.

If you are 12-14 and interested, there will be three non-acting roles available to students: **Stage Managing, Costume/Makeup Design, and Sound/Light Design.**
